

GREATER THAN: THE FINAL WORD

Creation - Go outside for 15-20 min. and read aloud/reflect on Psalm 19:1, Colossians 1:16-17, & Revelation 4:11,

Roman 1:18-20 tells us creation reveals God's "eternal power and divine nature". How does it do that?

Did you know? Creation is groaning (shaking-Hebrews 12:27) just as we are suffering? Read Romans 8:18-23

Revelation - How do we know God has spoken? Fulfilled prophecy. No other religion has it like the Bible.

Extra laps: Genesis 3:15, Psalm 22, Isaiah 9, Isaiah 53, Micah 5:1-5 God's Word is worth suffering for.

Incarnation - Jesus is God in human flesh. Why would Jesus leave heavens comfort to a suffer in this world?

Was it partly to help us in our suffering? Hebrews 12:1-6

Purification - Memorize Hebrews 1:1-3 and meditate on the truth Jesus provides purification for your ALL our sins.

How did Jesus purify us? Hebrews 9:11-14 Learn and Live in purity!

Exaltation - Let us exalt Jesus in our daily conversations at home, school, and work. If you can play Christian songs on the radio to fill the home, school, and workplace with words that exalt Jesus.

Imagine Jesus listening to our every word in our conversations -wait a minute- he hears -so speak as a humble servant of the King of Kings with love, kindness, gentleness, and truthfulness knowing we will give account of every word we speak.

In my thoughts and conversations is Jesus greater than all others, all things? If not, ask Jesus for forgiveness and ask the Holy Spirit for strength to exalt Jesus in our thoughts and words.
