

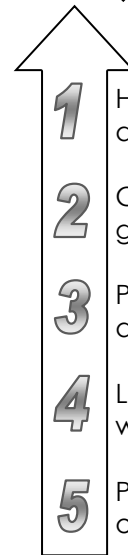

- 1 Host a planning dinner or dessert to talk about the place and day and time for your meetings.
- 2 Contact each person/couple to tell them about the LIFE group vision and ask if they might be interested.
- 3 Prayerfully consider eight to twelve people who might enjoy and enrich one another in a LIFE group.
- 4 Learn how to lead a meeting (talk to staff; talk to leaders; watch a group in action; read a book; watch a video; etc)
- 5 Pray about the desire/leading you have to help start or lead or host a LIFE group.
